BEHAVIOURS THAT ARE CONSIDERED TO BE INAPPROPRIATE, CONCERNING OR THREATENING INCLUDE:

- angry, aggressive communications (verbal or written)
- unwanted attention
- written material (emails or letters) that suggest a community member's may be unstable or have mental health issues
- a statement about self-harm or suicide
- sexual harassment (unwelcome sexual conduct of any kind)
- a notable change in a community member's behaviour that is cause for concern
- stalking (repeated attempts to impose unwanted communication or contact)
- an uttered threat to harm another or damage property
- bullying (repeated, unreasonable conduct in the Centre)
- any act of physical violence, property damage, or production of a weapon *
- violent critical incident on center*
