Imam Adama Konda is currently Imam at Canberra Islamic Centre- Australian National Islamic Library (for Imam of Darwin Masjid) and is a Wellbeing teacher at the Islamic School of Canberra.

Imam Adama is originally from Burkina Faso but studied Islam in Syria, Madina and Malaysia. He arrived in Darwin in 1995. He did his English studies and has completed his Graduate Certificate of Education in 2006 from Charles Darwin University.

He has been actively involved with “Project Abraham” an interfaith program which explores the religious and historical commonalities between the three Abrahamic faiths funded by NT Government. The project was delivered to highlight the commonalities of their faiths and their common desire for peace and harmony among all peoples of all faiths.

He was awarded the Charles See Kee Awards (2008) and was the NT’s State Finalist for Australia’s Local Hero Award (2010).
